

Minutes of 26th meeting of the Empowered Committee held under the Convenership of Commr/Secretary to Government, Finance Department on 23-09-2011.

Subject: Regularization of Adhoc/Contractual/Consolidated employees.

Reference: Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services (Special Provisions) Act, 2010.

Twenty sixth meeting of the Empowered Committee was held on 23-09-2011 at 3.00 PM under the Convenership of Commr/Secretary to Government, Finance Department. The following officers attended:

One hundred and fifty two (152) cases of Technical Education, Higher Education, PHE, Transport & Animal Sheep Husbandry Departments were listed and placed before EC for consideration. The breakup of these cases is given as under:

Out of one hundred and fifty two cases, only thirty eight (38) cases have been found eligible and ninety four (94) cases were found deficient. Twenty cases (20) have been found ineligible as these cases have either not completed 7 years of service or do not fall within the purview of the Act. In respect of cases where 7 years are not complete, it was decided that these cases shall be returned to the concerned departments with the advice that they shall resubmit their cases complete in all respects as and when they complete 7 years of service. Abstract details are given in **Annexure "A"** to these minutes. So far as the deficient cases are concerned, the representatives of the departments who were present in the meeting were advised to expedite the relevant deficient information so that further action on the issue could be taken by the EC.

As far as the cases of Technical Education Department are concerned, who were engaged on academic arrangements, it was decided to seek a clarification from the concerned departments as to whether these employees are eligible in terms of the J&K Civil Services (Special Provisions) Act, if it is so, then only department shall furnish justification alongwith deficient information. Complete details of cases placed before the EC for scrutiny and verification is shown in **Annexure "B"** to these minutes.
