Subject: Contribution towards Hon'ble Chief Minister's Relief Fund.

Ref: Cabinet Decision No: 177/14/2010 dated: 10.08.2010 followed by Circular No: 16-GAD of 2010 dated: 23.08.2010.

CIRCULAR

Vide the above mentioned circular issued by the General Administration Department, it has specifically been informed that there has been a colossal human loss and devastation due to cloud bursts and floods at various places in Leh and other parts of the State. To augment the kitty of resources for relief, rehabilitation and restoration work in Leh and other flood hit areas of the State, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has, among others, appealed:-

- (i) the Council of Ministers to donate one month's or one week's salary; and
- (ii) Government employees to donate one day's salary.

towards Chief Minister's Relief Fund.

Accordingly, all Drawing and Disbursing Officers are enjoined up on to deduct one day's salary in respect of all the Government employees at source from their salaries for the month of August-2010 as donation towards Chief Minister's Relief Fund for the above purpose.

The amount deducted from the employees shall be credited to Account Number CD-16 maintained in the J&K Bank Branch Moving Secretariat.

All the Treasury Officers are, therefore, asked not to allow drawal of salary bills for the month of August 2010 in respect of any DDO unless a certificate regarding deduction of one day's salary of each employee billed for towards the Hon'ble Chief Minister's Relief Fund is recorded by the respective DDOs on the salary bills/cheques presented at the treasuries. In the event of any of the employee does not opt for such contribution or objects to such deduction the amount so deducted shall be got refunded from the Fund.
