Subject: Finalization of Seniority List of members of J&K Accounts (G) Service.

Government Order No. 144 – F of 2009

Whereas, the seniority list of members of J&K Accounts (G) Service as on 01.04.2009 was issued vide Government Order No.98-F of 2009 dated 11.05.2009; and

Whereas, the seniority of the officers from Seniority Serial 47 to 76 of Annexure 'D' and the officers included in Annexure 'E' of the seniority list was issued tentatively and the objections were invited from the officers to be filed in the Finance Department within a period for one month from the date of issue of the order; and

Whereas, the seniority list was uploaded on website, besides circulating amongst the members of the Service; and

Whereas, Shri Amit Kumar, Jr. Scale Accounts Officer (Sn. Sr. No.39) has represented that in the Select list of AO(Probationers) his name had been placed next to Ms. Monika Hans(Sn.Sr.36), whileas in the seniority list instead of placing him at Seniority Serial 37, he has been shown at Sn. Sr.39; and

Whereas, on perusal of the representation, it has been found that Shri Amit Kumar has been appointed as AO (Probationer) vide Govt. Order No.1219-GAD of 2004 dated 03.09.2004, whileas his batchmates including Ms. Monika Hans have been appointed as AO (Prob.) vide Govt. Order No.971-GAD of 2004 dated 23.07.2004; and

Whereas, during the intervening period of appointment of Ms. Monika Hans, *et-al* and Shri Amit Kumar, two departmental officers viz. S/Shri Vijay Kumar Gupta and V.K. Sawhney, have been regularized as Jr. Scale Accounts Officers by the DPC/PSC under departmental quota w.e.f. 01.08.2004 and 01.09.2004, respectively; and

Whereas, in terms of Rule 24 of J&K Civil Services (CC&A), Rules, 1956 Shri Amit Kumar has rightly been placed at seniority position 39 i.e. below S/Shri. Vijay Kumar Gupta and V.K.Sawhney, the date of regularization as Jr. Scale Accounts Officer of whom (departmental officers) the date of appointment precedes that of Shri Amit Kumar; and

Whereas, another officer, namely Shri Reyaz Hussain (ST), Sr. Scale Accounts Officer(Sn. Sr. No.74) has submitted that his seniority may be fixed in the Sr. Scale, as per the roster point allocated for the ST category on the analogy of Shri Mazhar Hussain(RBA); and

Whereas, on examination of the representation, it has been found that Shri Mazhar Hussain, who figured at Seniority Serial 42 of the feeding category (Jr. Scale AO) has been regularized as CAO w.e.f 24.03.2008 against the post/roster point meant

for RBA category, which post has become available prior to the post/roster point meant for ST category, against which Shri Reyaz Hussain(ST), Sn.Sr.49 of the feeding category(Jr. Scale AO) has been regularized as CAO; and

Whereas, Shri Reyaz Hussain has been regularized as Chief Accounts Officer, w.e.f. 25.07.2008 and even his seniors in the feeding category viz. S/Shri Ghulam Nabi Bhat(Sn.Sr.20), Abdul Samad Magrey(Sn.Sr.23),J.L.Tickoo,(Sn.Sr.24), S.K. Wazir,(Sn.Sr.25), Haroon Rashid(Sn/Sr.26), Harbhajan Singh (Sn.Sr.29), Krishan Singh(Sn.Sr.32),Miss. Bharti Samyal(Sn.Sr.36), Showkat Hussain Mir (RBA)(Sn.Sr.43), Kulbhushan Kumar (SC) (Sn.Sr.45) etc. were also regularized as CAOs by the DPC/PSC from 25.07.2008; and

Whereas, Shri Reyaz Hussain who earlier figured at the tail end of the seniority of feeding category, (Jr. Scale AO), by virtue of reservation rules, scored march over his seniors viz; S/Shri Raman Gupta, Vishal Sharma, Ms. Tabbasum and Ashok Kumar; and

Whereas, Rule 31 of Jammu & Kashmir Reservation Rules, 2005(SRO 294 of 2005) envisages that the roster prescribed for direct recruitment/promotion shall only be an aid to determine the entitlement of different categories with regard to quota reserved for them and the roster is not meant for determination of seniority. It, inter-alia, further provides that the inter-se seniority of category candidates vis-à-vis general category candidates shall be determined in accordance with the merit/seniority in the feeding cadre and Rule 24(a) of J&K Civil Services (CC&A), Rules, 1956. In view of the rules, the seniority of Shri Reyaz Hussain has been fixed correctly at Sn. Sr.74 of Annexure 'D' of the seniority list.

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that the tentative seniority of officers from seniority serial 47 to 76 of Annexure 'D' and the officers listed in Annexure 'E', notified vide Govt. Order No.98-F of 2009 dated 11.05.2009 is also declared as 'final', subject to following conditions:-

- i) The seniority position of Shri Raman Kumar, I/C. FA&CAO, Education department (Sn.Sr.3 of annexure 'E') for whom a post of Chief Accounts Officer has been reserved from 01.09.2008 by the DPC/PSC, shall be fixed at appropriate place in Annexure 'D' of the seniority list as and when the officer is cleared by the DPC.
- ii) The seniority position of below mentioned Jr. Scale Accounts Officers, for whom posts have been reserved by the DPC/PSC from the dates shown against each, shall be fixed at appropriate place in Annexure 'E' of the seniority list, as and when, they will be cleared by the DPC:-
