Minutes of the Meeting held under the Chairmanship Principal Secretary to Government, Finance Department, J&K on 26th March 2024 at 1:30 PM in Civil Secretariat, Jammu.

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to Government, Finance Department J&K on 26th March 2024 at 1:30 PM in the meeting hall on first floor in Civil Secretariat Jammu to review the monitoring mechanism and progress of Centrally Sponsored Schemes for their effective implementation.

Two power point presentations were given in the meeting - one by Director Expenditure Division II and another by State Nodal Officer, PFMS, J&K.

The chair was appraised that development expenditure is being monitored by Expenditure Division-I and II divisions on monthly basis by compiling MPRs submitted by DDCs and Departments, However, these MPRs are being prepared without perusing BEAMS and PFMS portals, which is resulting in data gaps in reporting and mismatch of figures in MPRs with these Portals. Following points were agreed to improve monitoring/ reporting:-

- a Improvements by Planning officials divisions: Expenditure of BEAMS should be adopted for UT/ District Sector and information of bills submitted to treasury to be shared separately. Expenditure against advance drawl of UT/ District Sector to be reported separately, MPRs of CSS should include revenue expenditure also.
- b. Improvements by Budget Division: The BEAMS portal may be updated so that separate statement of state share of CSS is made available on BEAMS. Date-wise and scheme-wise releases may be displayed on BEAMS. Further, viewing access on works on BEAMS for respective Departmental works be provided to all Planning Officers Provision for viewing budget for works indicated as

physically completed on BEAMS until their financial closure.

c. Improvements by Resource & PFMS Division: PFMS Login IDs should be provided to Heads of Planning in all Administrative Departments for seamless viewing of all reports of the respective department. Followup may be done with central PFMS authorities so that All left out CSS/ CS (like RDSS, PM-KUSUM) are onboarded on PFMS and so that segregation of expenditure in respect of funds released through implementing agency and state treasury as well as against central share and state Share is made available on PFMS.

The chair was apprised that total availability of central share during the FY 2023-24 is about Rs. 15,000 crore against which expenditure of Rs 11300 crore stand incurred and about Rs 3700 is available in SNA balance. The Nodal Officer PFMS presented various PFMS reports and statement of releases by Gol and expenditure incurred during the last two years as well as CFY. He highlighted the following:-

- Improvement in ranking of J&K amongst all the States/ UTs in sharing of SLS-wise data on PFMS ( from 31st on 8.1.24 to 9th on 19.03.2024)
- b. Head of Account Mapping Status (100% mapped)
- Schemes with less expenditure against funds released by GoI (8 Schemes)
- d. Schemes with Bank balances exceeding one crore (80 schemes)
- e. Schemes in which interest deposited is less (86 schemes)
- Schemes in which funds transferred to SNA account after 30 days (38 Schemes)
- g. Schemes having major (more than Rs 100 crore) deficit in transfer of money from treasury to SNA (4 Schemes)

Principal Secretary to Government, Finance Department, emphasized that PFMS and BEAMS portals have to be monitored regularly by all Finance and Planning Department Officers on a weekly basis to ensure 100% utilization of central funds (capex & revenue). He also advised Planning Officers to focus on completion of languishing projects, JKPCC works and NABARD works approved from 2016-17 to 2018-19 (RIDF 20 to 24).

Consequent to the discussions, following directions were given by the Principal Secretary, Finance:-
